First Quarter 2026 Finances for Salem Lutheran Church

We give thanks for the generosity and care from all the members and friends of the church. Every gift blesses the congregation.

In the month of March, Salem's total income was \$34,103 and total expenses were \$29,074. Through the first quarter of 2026, total income was \$86,631 as compared to income of \$86,533 in 2025 and the budgeted income of \$81,758. Total expenses in the first quarter were \$88,593 as compared to \$95,802 in 2025 and the budget amount of \$86,692. Expenses exceeded income by \$1,962 as compared to \$9,269 in 2025.

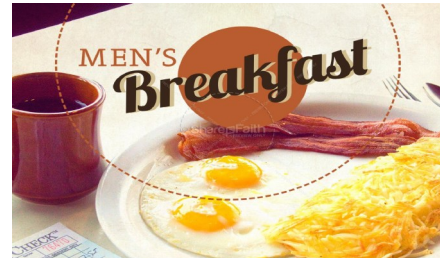
